

PRESIDNET'S MESSAGE

Happy summer, everyone! I am honored to be taking on the role of President. I am grateful for all the support I have received leading up to this role and looking forward to a productive two years. I am excited to work with our amazing clergy and professional staff, and a great cadre of lay leaders both on and off the Board. In this, my first column as President, I would like to tell you a little bit about myself.

I was born and raised in Jerusalem, and moved to Tel Aviv for my university studies. I spent time in New Jersey while studying at Rutgers University, moved back to Israel and lived in Haifa, then in England for a few years. We finally settled in Long Beach in 2007 when my wife, Nancy, got a job as a Linguistics professor at Cal State. I too am a linguist, and for the past two decades I have been working in language technologies. Nancy and I have three children - two in college and one in high school. I became a U.S. citizen in 2010 (at the citizenship ceremony, the judge noted that our Governator at the time was also an immigrant). I am still very much in touch with Israel, and we visit regularly since my family all live

As a secular Israeli, I honestly find it somewhat surprising to be part of a Reform Temple, let alone President. As a friend in New Jersey once commented to me, in Israel you don't need to go to shul to feel Jewish. Indeed, for many years I didn't feel this need, and we only joined the Temple when my daughter Carmel

wanted to have a bat mitzvah in 2018.

What we found in Temple Israel is a loving community and a deep sense of connection. Since joining I have become more involved, first in committees and then on the Board, serving as Secretary and Vice President of Ritual Practices before assuming my current role.

Having experienced various ways of practicing Judaism, there are many things I appreciate about the Reform movement, not the least of which is the acceptance of interfaith families like ours. I also appreciate that since October 7, 2023, the Reform movement has been steadfast in calling for the release of the hostages - all of them - and defending Israel's right to exist peacefully, while also expressing empathy for casualties on all sides, condemning the excessive use of force, and demanding that we stick to our principles, for example by declaring that starving Gaza is immoral (Rabbi Rick Jacobs in the Washington Post, May 12, 2025). At a time when parts of the Jewish world turn towards the rhetoric of selfrighteousness and self-absorption, I am proud to be affiliated with a movement

that has the courage to speak out.

I'd like to end this column with a small mystery. At Temple Israel we have a mobile ark which we use for Torah services outdoors – for example, at the Rosh HaShanah Celebration in the Park which will take place next month. This ark has a curious decoration: a reverse Nun character on each door. What is the significance of this decoration, and why is it placed on the mobile ark? Please write to me with any thoughts or guesses; I'll reveal the answer in next month's column.



Events include Service Programs like Feeding the Unhoused in which several of you continue to be of great service along with Thanksgiving Meal Prep which is coming up in November; Celebration Events like the Annual Interfaith Unity Awards Dinner (many Temple members have been recipients); and Education Initiatives like How Do We Talk about Israel & Palestine? (Sept. 28) and Exploring Sacred Spaces (Aug. 24) at the Sikh Center of OC.

President Rosenberg concluded his letter by stating: "we can create spaces in which we can learn from, inspire and help one another" ... something our world sorely needs.






